III. Using the Account

There are two Linux server: <u>amax.sscnet.ucla.edu</u> and <u>nicco.sscnet.ucla.edu</u>. Accounts should be available within two working days of submitting your form. Normally, your user ID would be your first initial and the first seven letters of your last name. The first time you log in, the system will ask you to enter a password. If you do not do this within five working days, the account will be blocked. If you have problems, you should contact Julie Chen at 5-7335 (chenj@ssc.ucla.edu).

After your first year you may renew your account by emailing your name and student ID number to <u>cheni@ssc.ucla.edu</u>.
